<p>There is a bug in the warden backend script startjail.sh that causes the ipfw filter table to always get flushed before a new NAT rule is inserted. If you have more than one NATed jail the rules for those get lost then when the next jail is started.</p> <p>The cause for this is that sysrc in the current FreeNAS by default reports the variable names and the values but the script only checks for the value.</p> <p>Please see attached patch to fix the issue by telling sysrc to only report the values of firewall_enable and firewall_type</p> <p>Regards, Ben</p>
