#### Description

The old GUI has included the documentation for the installed version for a while now. It is present on the server.

The new GUI has a link to the documentation, but instead of redirecting users to the copy stored on the server, it's a link to doc.freenas.org (see image). This feels incredibly silly and can be misleading, since there may be a mismatch between the version on the internet and the installed version of FreeNAS.

The new GUI's link should probably point to the local copy (in a new tab-friendly way, if possible).
