Description	
The legacy web gui typically fails to load for me under 11.0-U3 (fresh install). The chrome dev console shows a js error about 'decimalFormat', picture and log attached.	
I believe this is some kind of race condition as I can sometimes load the page, maybe 1/10 times. And if I set chrome to simulate a "Fast 3G Network", then the gui will consistently load. I have not observed any such problems with the new gui.

Just FYI, I upgraded FreeNAS from 9 to 11 because I experienced this issue in version 9, but according to ticket [#26115](#) you are not planning to fix this in version 9. However, as you are aware this is still an issue in version 11 as evident in this ticket and [#25979](#). I am watching this ticket to see when it's ready so I can install the patch, but I just wanted to let you know that folks on version 9 will still probably want a patch, as John Pierce points out above. You may want to consider back-porting this patch if it is not too onerous. Thanks!

FYI - I'm seeing the same issue on Firefox Beta (aka "Quantum"), version 57. Ironically, page came up fine for me in Chrome, and then came up on Firefox after I refreshed the page. Firefox 57 is due for general release in November, so this issue may soon become much more widespread.
