#### Description

The old GUI referred to "Volumes". For 11.3, we were going to change this to "Pools". It appears we are doing this early, and some of the new GUI has changed, but much has not.

Every place that said "Volume" should now say "Pool". Saying "ZFS Pool" is redundant.

The entry under the Storage menu still says "Volumes".

When Volumes is clicked, the page says "ZFS Pools". This should just say "Pools".

When no pools exist, it says "No ZFS Pools found", but should say just "No pools."

The "hamburger" button has entries for

"Create ZFS Pool" which should be "Create Pool".

"Import Volumes" which should be "Import Volume" (singular, it only imports one at a time).

"UnEncrypt Non Imported Volumes" which is... confusing. That should probably be just "Unencrypt Pool", but from the prompt, I'm not sure what it really does.

The screen that goes to also has the odd "UnEncrypt" capitalization. Maybe it has a special meaning?
