Someone said in the comments for that, we would need to be able to rename the jail or something, so that might be related.

There were a few bugs with the "rename" functionality in the older versions of iocage, but it should work in 11.2-BETA2 (from the command line). This is indeed a possible workaround to install the same plugin more than once.

Note that there's very similar request logged already to implemented the "rename" functionality in the new UI:
