<p>I'm testing the new UI with a FreeNAS system updated to the latest FreeNAS-11-Nightly version. I navigated to VMs, created a new Docker VM, and clicked Devices -&gt; (RAW) More Options -&gt; Edit for that Docker VM. The screen that opens is completely blank with options to Save or Cancel. I switched to the old UI and followed a similar procedure to edit the existing RAW device: a popup window appears with 8 different configurable fields.</p>
