Description When filtering lists, the filter searches for text in any of the columns, including those that contain only the words "true" or "false." This can lead to seemingly inconsistent results; maybe add an option to refine the filter to one or multiple specific column(s), or remove the filter entirely (the already present sorting feature seems more intuitive and efficient unless a list contains a LARGE number of items).
