<p>I'm testing the new UI with a FreeNAS Mini on INTERNAL8</p> <p>I added a new Cloud Credential for a test Backblaze account, then realised I needed to change the name. I opened the "Edit" screen for the credential, changed the "Name" field, and clicked "Save". An error called " 'id' " appears, with this additional text:</p> <pre>... <p>Interestingly enough, after navigating away and returning to the Cloud Credentials screen a few minutes later, the new name was applied to the credential. Attempting to edit and change the name of the credential still generates that 'id' error message though.</p>
