- 2) Create time machine share owned by local user
- 3) Enable LDAP
- 4) Configure Time Machine backup on OSX client.
- 5) Monitor /var/log/auth.log for entries like above.

The issue is still present in 11.2, but was masked by a separate bug related to the generation of the /etc/pam.d/netatalk file.
