Description	
The GUI has no active field to enter a default router for IPv4.	
Create a jail, call it "junk," with vnet0, an IPv4 address (<ipaddr>), and netmask=24 in the GUI w/o a default router. Then, in the CLI, SSH as root and enter:	
<pre>iocage console junk</pre>	
and you get this message:	
<pre>ifconfig interface vnet0 does not exist jail: /sbin/ifconfig vnet0 inet <ipaddr>/24 alias failed</pre>

Testing with FreeNAS system updated to FreeNAS-11.2-MASTER-201808300858:

Log in and go to Jails > Add. Create jail 41308 with VNET set, an IPv4 Address and Netmask manually configured, but no Default Router set. Go to Shell and enter

```
iocage console 41308
```

. System connects to jail and eventually displays

```
root@41308:~ #
```

.

SSH into testing system from outside computer. Enter

```
iocage console 41308
```

. Same results. No errors encountered.
